### Ethics Policy

The Australian Boys Choral Institute (ABCI) will not accept any financial assistance or sponsorship (or give any endorsement) which involves promotion of the use of alcohol, tobacco or of gambling.

The Vocal Consort may accept such assistance or give such endorsement in appropriate circumstances, with the exception of the promotion of tobacco products.

While the ABCI performs a wide range of sacred and secular music, the Institute has no religious affiliation.

The ABCI respects the intellectual property rights of musicians and other artists.

In appropriate cases the Institute may refuse financial support from anyone who does not adhere to its policies and procedures.

#### Regular review

This policy will be reviewed at least every two years.
